



USING THIS GUIDE:

This guide has been published to assist students in preparing for transfer to Webster University from East Central College in the areas of Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, or Finance. This should not be used in place of individual academic advising. Students are strongly encouraged to meet with a Webster University transfer admissions counselor early in their academic career to ensure a smooth transfer experience.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

- taken at Webster University.
- No more than one course completed with a grade of D may count toward fulfilling the specific requirements of the major. All General Education/GCP courses must be completed with a C-or higher.
- Webster University provides full transfer of coursework successfully completed as part of an associate degree awarded by a regionally accredited institution. While students with associate degrees typically transfer 60-64 credit hours, Webster will transfer in all coursework that is part of the completed associate degree. Transfer of additional lower-division credit beyond the associate degree is restricted. All transfer credit is capped at 98 credit hours.
- All transfer coursework must be college-level (100-level or above) with a passing grade. Pass/Fail courses will count for transfer credit if the student received a Pass. For repeated courses only the second grade will be
